Sunday – 1:00 to 6:00.

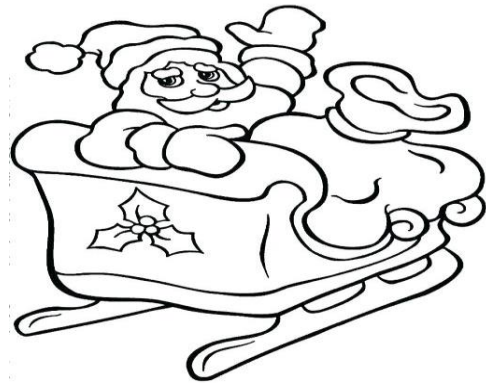

For anything other than normal every day trash there will be a charge depending on what it is. **HOWEVER, IF YOU ARE SAVING UP YOUR HOUSEHOLD TRASH FOR WEEKS AT A TIME AND HAVE A PICKUP BED OR TRAILER FULL, YOU WILL BE CHARGED A MINIMUM OF \$20 DOLLARS TO DUMP IT.**
