DUMP HOURS

THE DUMP HOURS HAVE MADE A SLIGHT CHANGE.

Please take note that the dump will now be open from 3 to 6 on WEDNESDAY, instead of Thursday

Wednesday – 3:00 to 6:00

Saturday – 8:00 to 5:00

Sunday – 1:00 to 6:00.

The dumpsters are free for stockholders to throw regular, everyday, household trash. All household trash must be bagged. Household trash is normal everyday trash, kitchen, bathroom, etc. It does not include furniture, carpet, appliances, lumber, or cleaning out a house. For anything other than normal everyday trash there will be a charge depending on what it is. **HOWEVER, IF YOU ARE SAVING UP YOUR HOUSEHOLD TRASH FOR WEEKS AT A TIME AND HAVE A PICKUP BED OR TRAILER FULL, YOU WILL BE CHARGED A MINIMUM OF \$20 DOLLARS TO DUMP IT.**

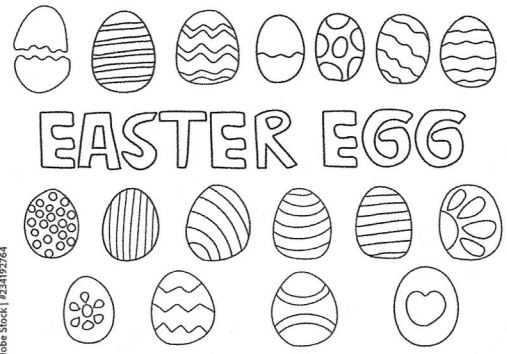

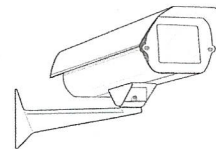
